IF EITHER PARTY BELIEVES ORAL SUBMISSION IS NECESSARY, BRIEFS MUST STILL BE SUBMITTED AS AFORESAID, AND THE PARTY REQUESTING ORAL SUBMISSION SHOULD OBTAIN LEAVE FROM THE TRIAL COURT TO DO SO.
