Discuss, consider, and/or take action to appoint Dr. Charles Addington as the Acting Chief Medical Examiner pursuant to Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Article 49.25, directly related to the emergency and urgent public necessity caused by an epidemic (the COVID -19 pandemic) and its effects, which requires immediate action of this government body pursuant to Texas Government Code § 551.045 effective July 13, 2020.

Upon a motion by Bill McCay, seconded by Chad Seay, the court unanimously voted approving to appoint Dr. Charles Addington as the Acting Chief Medical Examiner pursuant to Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Article 49.25, directly related to the emergency and urgent public necessity caused by an epidemic (the COVID -19 pandemic) and its effects, which requires immediate action of this government body pursuant to Texas Government Code § 551.045 effective July 13, 2020.
